Narrative

Employees involved: Security Supervisor Shane Pearman #19746, Security Officer Scott Thompson #19953, and Security Officer Garry Canellis #19966.

On Thursday, February 15, 2011 at approximately 2357 hours, I overheard a call on the radio from Security Officer Scott Thompson #19953 stating that there was a patron medical situation at the west doors. I immediately responded to the west doors where I met with Security Supervisor Shane Pearman #19746, Security Officer Thompson, and Security Officer Garry Canellis #19966. We found patron Marcel Metcalf lying on the ground just outside the west doors, in the foyer. Mr. Metcalf's son, Scott Metcalf was standing by with another unidentified female. Another patron, Ms. Rebecca Moore, who said she was a friend, was holding Mr. Metcalf's head in her lap. Supervisor Pearman attempted to converse with Mr. Metcalf, but he was unresponsive. Pearman directed security dispatch to call 911 at 2359 hours.

While waiting for the paramedics, I asked Mr. Metcalf, who had identified himself as his son, what had happened. He stated that they had been gaming at slot bank number 113 and had decided to leave. As they were leaving, Mr. Metcalf bumped into the door and fell to the ground. I inquired as to his health and activities prior to her falling. Moore responded that he had been drinking all day, and she thought he was just asleep since she wouldn't respond to our questions. I asked him if Mr. Metcalf had any identification and she said no.

AMR arrived at 0008 hours and CDF arrived at 0011 hours. Paramedic questioned Mr. Metcalf in Spanish and he told them that he was having some pain in his lower back. He refused to try and

stand, so the paramedics loaded him onto a gurney and transported him. They departed the property at 0022 hours. A review of the video in surveillance revealed that Mr. Metcalf did not bump into the door. He walked through the doors without touching them, then just collapsed once outside the doors. It was unclear how long the patrons had been in the casino. A search of the data base revealed no previous contacts with either Ms. Metcalf senior or Mr. Metcalf junior. There was one prior contact with a patron identified as Rebecca Moore.
